Introductions: Council Member Edwards in attendance. The city is faced with a number of opportunities and challenges including a \$126 million shortfall for the year. She is serving as Transportation Committee Chair and Budget & Fiscal Affairs Vice Chair. CM Edwards addressed several topics including the MP Livable Centers Study; development; mobility, bike mobility is perhaps in line first for transportation attention; and parking, suggesting public/private partnerships to develop parking garages. Current ordinances don't work for Museum Park and she suggested the possibility of identifying MP as Cultural district with different ordinances. Concerning Palm Street Closure, CM Edwards will assist with 'in place procedures' to review.

President's Report

- **Livable Centers Study** is asking for review of *Summary Needs Assessment*. Send remarks to Natalia by the 19th and cc Kathleen.
- **Palm Street (1100) Closure.** Next steps? MPSN met with developer at last month's meeting. No assurances that Palm Street would not be closed. Significant opposition from MPSN Council was expressed last month. Meeting with Planning and Public Works is an option. Asking CM Boykins and Edwards to set up meeting with Andy Icken. Goals for a meeting include understanding the process of abandonment and opposing the loss of public right of way.
- SN Alliance is preparing a report for the city-the LCS will be included

Alex: Meeting with AJ Villa to understand work that has already been done by MP. Kathy Easterly at University Place is additional resource. Museums have been asking about quarterly meetings that have been organized by MPSN. Alex attended January PIP meeting, where Open Carry was a topic.
