Who to refer

Intoxicated patients who are:

- Ambulatory
- Non-violent
- 18 years of age and older
- Medically stable for discharge home

What is "stable"

- Ambulatory or able to walk with limited assistance
- Open wounds sutured/dressed as appropriate
- Head injuries medically cleared
- Any emergent medical or psychiatric conditions stabilized as for discharge home

How to initiate the referral

What to send along with Patient

- Patient's one month supply of medications if available
- Copy of patient discharge summary

Not appropriate referrals

Patients who are:

- Unable to walk
- Not willing to receive assistance
- Facing a critical illness
- Facing a mental health crisis (active suicidal, homicidal, hallucinations etc.)

Houston Recovery Center Available Services:

- Short term intervention for substance use and co-occurring substance use disorders
- Safe environment with basic EMT level screening and monitoring while sobering
- Peer Recovery Support Specialists offering individual recovery guidance
- Licensed Chemical Dependency Counselors for clients interested in substance use treatment services
- Community resource specialist works with clients to obtain basic essential needs such as: clothing, food, housing assessment and other resources
- Showers and change of clothes
- 18-month recovery program for those requesting assistance with addiction
